## FEES:

Our fee structure offers generous discounts for those doing multiple classes. The more classes that your child is enrolled in, the larger the discount. All class fees must be paid whether class is attended or not. This includes illness and family holidays taken during our dance term. However, your child may do catch up classes in other styles to make up for the missed lessons.

Paying by term is the preferred choice for all students, offering a 5% discount to all parents if Term Fees are settled by week 2. For those preferring monthly advance payments due to financial considerations, this option is also available. All prices are inclusive of GST, and fees must always be kept current. Families with two children attending a combined total of 10 classes per week automatically receive a 5% discount.

# CLASSES WE TEACH

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## PRE SCHOOL 2.5 - 4.5 YRS

Our Pre School combo class incorporates Ballet, Funky Hip Hop & Tap Dancing steps all in the one class. Perfect for beginners to learn multiple genres.

## BALLET

Ballet training will improve your child's concentration, strength, discipline, grace and flexibility.

## TAP

Tap is about making music with your feet, it's a great workout, particularly for your legs. Tap classes will develop rhythm, style and sound.

## HIP HOP

Hip Hop is a street style of dance incorporating Popping, Locking and Urban Funk, performed to hip hop music or other styles of music.

## CONTEMPORARY

Contemporary dance is a more free form of movement, tending to be a fusion of ballet and jazz. Focusing on alignment, balance, flexibility and strength.

## THEATRE JAZZ

Musical theatre dance is more than just a particular style of dance, it's a way to embody a character and tell a story through dance. It's a great way to develop acting chops and performance abilities.

## DRAMA

This class aims to develop Children's Confidence, Creativity and Communication Skills. Including creative play, movement and emotions, mime, storytelling, improvisation and performance skills.

## POINTE

Pointe is a demanding style of dance that requires a lot of time, patience, and commitment to dance on your toes with traditional ballet technique.
